2021/2022 Report for Parish Meeting

This last year has seen less disruption to the activities of the garden club due to COVID and we still have 55 active member households with some new members joining over the year.

The start of 2021 saw no meetings but commencing in September, with a well attended visit to Beth Chatto's garden we have managed a full programme including the Christmas Party. 2022 has started well with talks in February, March and April and a coach trip to Anglesey Abbey in March to visit the house and Winter Garden. The remainder of the year has a full programme of talks, visits to local gardens and a club visit to Hampton Court in July. We are also planning to run Open Gardens in Great Finborough on the 19th June.
